## Afghanistan Opium Price Monitoring, February 2010

### Summary

- Opium prices are collected from 15 of 34 provinces. The prices are collected for dry and fresh opium from traders (Trader prices) and farmers (farm gate prices). Heroin and cannabis resin prices are also collected from six province of Afghanistan and Peshawar, the nearest town in Pakistan.

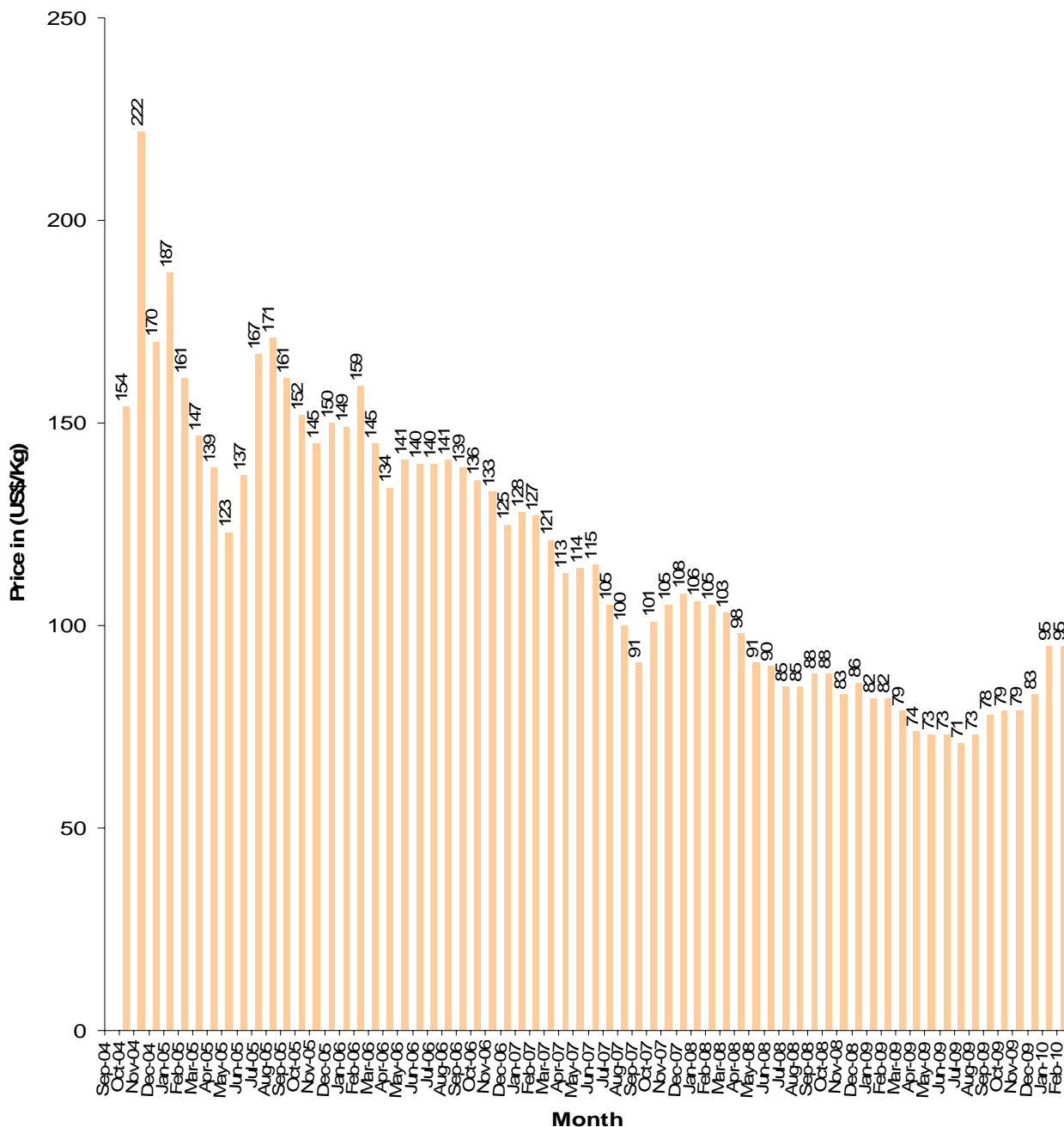
# DRY OPIUM:

## FARM GATE PRICE:

At the end of February 2010, the national average price for one kilogram of dry opium in Afghanistan at the farm gate level was stable with **US\$ 95/kg** compared to price reported in January 2010 (US\$ 95/kg). The dry opium price at the farm gate level has increasing trend since July 2009. Government campaign against poppy cultivation and fear of eradication might be the reasons behind the increasing trend.

The average dry opium price is 16% higher than the price reported in February 2009 which was US\$ 82/kg.

**TRADER PRICE:**

At the end of February 2010, the national average dry opium price collected from traders was **US\$ 101/kg** with 1% decrease compared to price reported in last month (US\$ 102/kg).

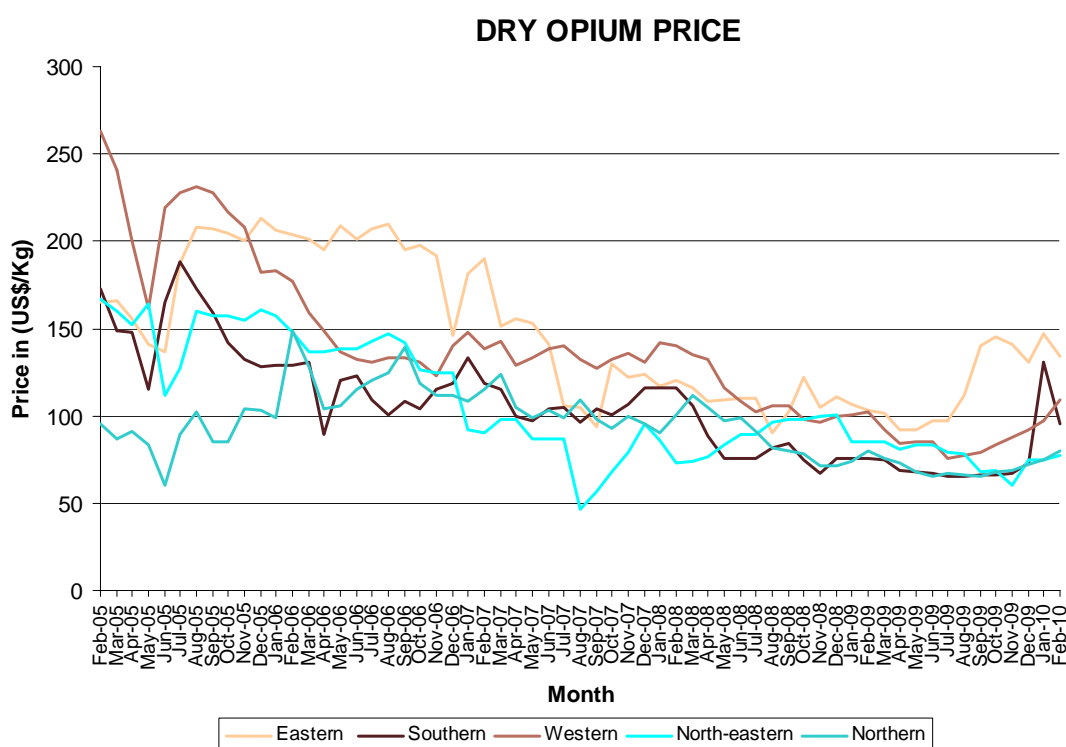
Dry opium price collected from traders has increased by 12%, 3%, 7% in Western, North eastern and Northern regions respectively. The trader price of dry opium has decreased by 9% and 27% in Eastern and Southern regions. The 27% decrease in Southern regions is due to low demand and strong control on Iran boarder.

The price of dry opium collected from traders in the eastern region is much higher compared to other regions and that is because very less opium is available in the eastern region since there was not much cultivation in 2008 and 2009. Also, easy access to Pakistan for trafficking the opium could be another factor behind the higher price.

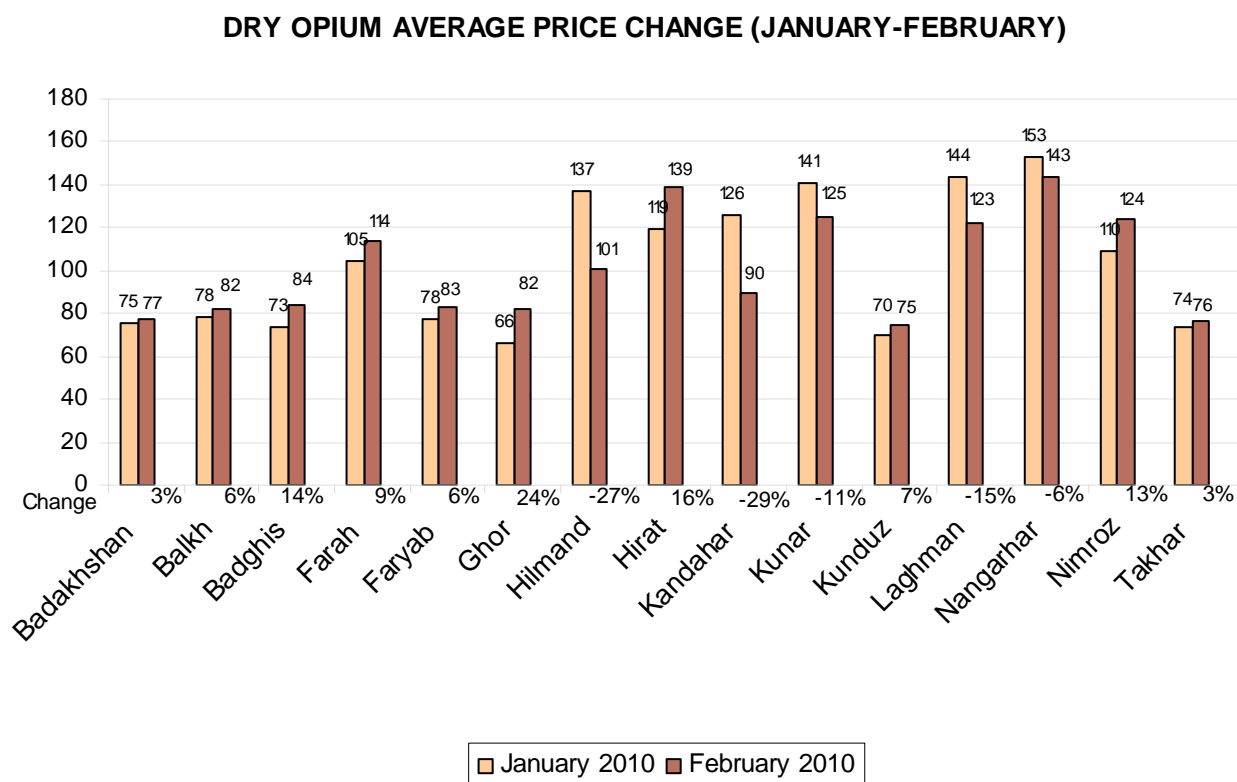
**Graph 2: Regional weighted<sup>2</sup> average price of dry opium from traders (January 2005- February 2010)**

Since June 2007, prices in the Eastern and Western regions are generally higher than the prices in other regions. Increase in prices in the Eastern and Western regions can be attributed to their strategic positions in trafficking bordering Pakistan and Iran respectively. Prices in Southern, Northern and North-eastern regions are generally lower than other regions since last few years.

**FRESH OPIUM:**

At the end of February 2010, the national average price of fresh opium was **US\$ 73/kg** at farm gate level with 2% increase and **US\$ 80/kg** at trader level with 2% increase compared to the prices reported last month. Fresh opium prices at farm gate and trader level were well above US\$100/kg till early 2007.

After the harvest season there is no fresh opium available, but farmers keep their fresh opium in plastic bags or dishes covered with leaves in order to preserve moisture. This opium is referred as fresh opium.

**HEROIN PRICES:**

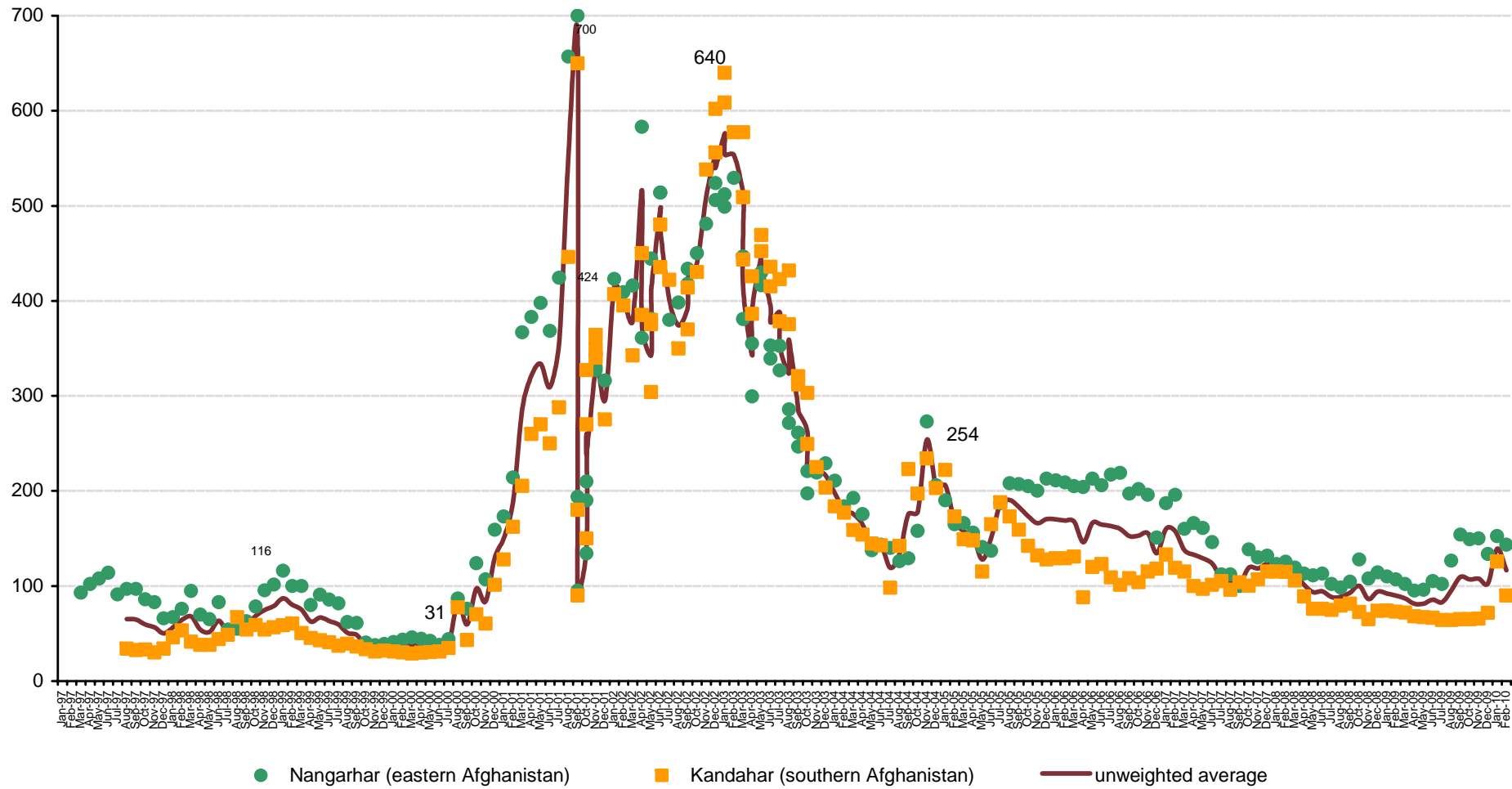

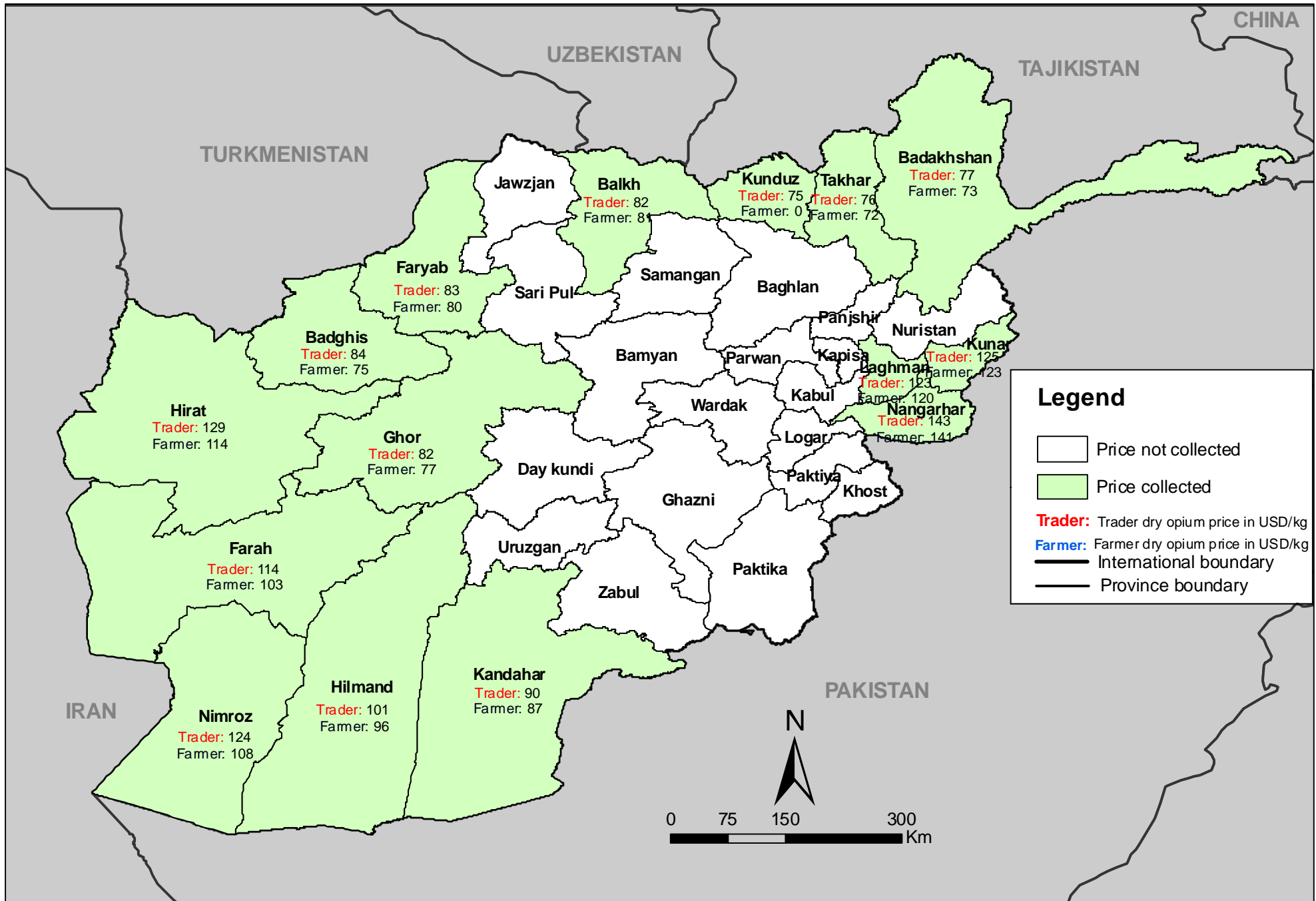
