

PERIODICAL REPORT ON POPPY ERADICATION IN AFGHANISTAN

Summary results as of 12 July 2020:

- Narcotics survey and analysis directorate of CNPA/MoIA monitor and verify governor-led eradication of poppy.
- Poppy is at lancing and harvested stages in Badkhshan province in Kabul, Kapisa, Kunar, Nangarhar, Laghman, Baghlan, Balkh, Sar-i-Pul, Faryab, Jawzjan, Kunduz, Takhar, DayKundi, Hilmand, Kandahar, Uruzgan, Zabul, Badghis, Ghor, Farah, Hirat and Nimruz provinces poppy is harvested.
- Governor-led eradication activities have been reported 972 hectares from Hilmand, Nangarhar, Badakhshan, Balkh, Nimruz, Hirat, Jawzjan, Kunar and Laghman provinces.
- Total eradication carried out is **972 hectares.**
- Measurements of eradicated fields reported by the survey coordinators. Therefore, the figures in this report should be considered as provisional report.
- Farmers' resistance against poppy eradication operations were occurred as mine explosion and direct attack on eradication team. Since the start of eradication operations this year 2 Afghan National Police were killed and 1 Afghan National Police was injured in Nawa-i-Barukzai district of Hilmand province and 4 others were killed in Argo district of Badakhshan province.
- Still there is no survey recruitment contract among UNODC and MoIA.

The narcotics survey and analysis directorate of CNPA/MoIA have responsibility for the preparing of weekly eradication report. Governor-led eradication activities are envisaged in all poppy cultivating provinces.

Results:

Governor-led eradication activities are reported from Hilmand, Nangarhar, Badakhshan, Balkh, Nimruz, Hirat, Jawzjan, Kunar and Laghman provinces. Table 2 shows the current status of the eradication activities by provinces.



Figure 1: Provincial eradication (by province)




Southern region (Hilmand):

• In Hilmand province, governor-led poppy eradication operations started on 31 March 2020 and concluded on 17 April 2020 in Naher-i-Saraj, Nad Ali, Nawa-i-Barukzai, Garm Ser and Lashkargah (Provincial Center) districts. A total of **384** hectares were reported by NSAD survey coordinators.



Eastern region (Nangarhar, Laghman and Kunar):

- In Nangarhar province, governor-led poppy eradication operations started on 9 April 2020 and concluded on 30 April 2020 in Khugyani, Dur baba, Shinwar, Rodat, Chaparhar and Bati kot districts. A total of **125** hectares were reported by NSAD survey coordinators.
- In Laghman province, governor-led poppy eradication operations started on 5 May 2020 and concluded on 6 May 2020 in Mehterlam (Provincial Center). A total of 1 hectare was reported by NSAD survey coordinators.
- In Kunar province, governor-led poppy eradication operations started on 17 May 2020 and concluded on 19 May 2020 in Bar Kunar (Asmar) and Dangam districts. A total of **1.4** hectare was reported by NSAD survey coordinators.



Western region (Nimruz, Hirat):

- In Nimruz province, governor-led poppy eradication operations started on 7 April 2020 and concluded on 12 April 2020 in Chahar Burjak, Zaranj(Provincial Center) and Asl-i-Chakhansur districts. A total of **6** hectares were reported by NSAD survey coordinators.
- In Hirat province, governor-led poppy eradication started on 3 May 2020 and concluded on 22 May 2020 in Adraskan district. A total of **3** hectares were reported by NSAD survey coordinators.



Note: Along the Khashrood road about 20-hectare poppy land has been destroyed by flood.


Northern region (Balkh):

- In Balkh province, governor-led poppy eradication operations started on 7 May 2020 and concluded on 13 May 2020 in Shortepa, Chimtal and Dehdadi districts. A total of **12** hectares were reported by NSAD survey coordinators.
- In Jawzjan province, governor-led poppy eradication operations started on 16 May 2020 and concluded on 17 May 2020 in Sheberghan (Provincial Center). A total of **3** hectares were reported by NSAD survey coordinators.



North-eastern region (Badakhshan):


• In Badakhshan province, governor-led poppy eradication operations started on 4 June 2020 in Argo, Kishim and Darayim districts. A total of **436** hectares were reported by NSAD survey coordinators.
